Note From Your Interim Pastor....

Jesus is often called "The Great Physician." This description of Jesus is not given in the Bible in those specific words, but the truth of the picture is surely found there. There are many stories of Jesus providing physical healing.

One day, Jesus met a group of men who were living in isolation from their families and the rest of the world. Their separation from everyone was not by choice, but by law and necessity. Each of them lived with the disease of leprosy. This meant that they could have no fellowship with family or friends, unless they too, had leprosy. Life was a bitter, hard existence with no hope for the future and no opportunity for a better life.

Then, Jesus came close to the place where these men lived. Luke 17:11-12 tells us, "***Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. 12 Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off.***" NKJV. Was this a village where only people with leprosy lived? If so, what did the disciples think as they approached the village, knowing the danger of their own exposure to the disease? How would you have felt as you watched ten men with leprosy stand and shout, "***Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!***"? Luke 17:13, NKJV.

The power of Jesus Christ over sickness and disease is vividly displayed in the next few words, --- Luke 17:14... "***So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.***" NKJV.

Not only is Jesus able to heal physical problems, He is able to heal spiritual conditions as well. He is the Great Physician of the soul. Thank God for this facet of the person of Jesus Christ!
