## STAYING SENSITIVE TO THE SPIRIT

I am excited about what God is doing at Calvary Baptist Church! We have just come through an awesome summer. God is showing up in our worship services with a tangible sense of His presence, and God is adding to our number regularly. Numerous groups in the church are exploring new ways to reach out to our community. Great things are happening, but I feel like we're just scraping the frost off the tip of the iceberg of what God wants to do in us, for us and through us in coming days and months if we will walk in obedience to God's Word and in harmony with God's Spirit. R.T. Kendall is a Kentucky native who went to England to study for his doctorate and ended up staying for 25 years as pastor of Westminster Chapel. In his book called *The Sensitivity of the Spirit*, he shares the story of a British couple, Sandy and Bernice, who served as missionaries in Israel. After they moved into the house provided for them near Jerusalem, they noticed that a dove had come to live in the eaves of the house. Since the dove is symbolic in the Bible of the Holy Spirit, they considered the dove's presence to be somewhat of a seal of approval from the Lord, a confirmation that they were in the right place. Soon, however, they noticed a pattern in the dove's behavior. Every time a door slammed shut – or if there was a lot of noise in the house, or if they raised their voices – the dove would be disturbed and flutter off, sometimes not returning for some time. This worried them, and they feared they were in danger of chasing the dove away permanently. As they discussed it together, Sandy said, "Well, it's obvious the dove won't adjust to our behavior, so we must adjust our behavior to the dove." The lesson from that real-life parable is fairly obvious. If we want the presence of the Heavenly Dove to manifest and remain on our lives, our ministries, and our church, we must adjust our behavior to Him. The devil doesn't like in the least the good things that are happening in our church, but he is incapable of quenching the Spirit. His only option is to tempt *us* to grieve the Spirit and quench His working in our midst through our attitudes, our words, or our actions. Now is especially the time to "*Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls*

*around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in your faith...*" (I Peter 5:8-9).

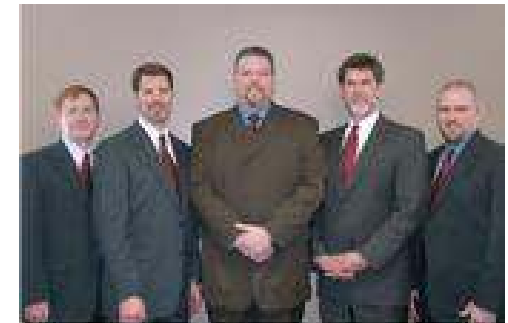
