## Note From Your Interim Pastor....

Jesus said, "*Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head.*" Matthew 8:20 NKJV. These words help us to better understand the extreme neediness which Jesus experienced when He came to live on earth. The Maker of all things lived as if He possessed nothing. The One who is the supplier of our needs experienced the depths of human need. The One who is the shelter in the time of our storm knew the full power of the storm of sin, which would swallow us up, if not for His mercy toward us.

John, the apostle of Christ, also gives us a picture of Jesus in need. In John, chapter 4, we read, --- "*Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour. A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her, "Give Me a drink."*

The picture we see is one of tiredness and exhaustion. If it were possible to look into the face of Jesus, in that moment, we might see the His eyelids drooping in the heat and fatigue of the day. Dropping our gaze to His feet, we would see the dust and grime of the road on His feet and sandals. The smell of a sweaty body would surround Him. His hair and beard might appear rather ruffled and uncombed for a man who claims to be the Son of God.

But, Jesus is the Son of God. He is the living Son of God, even today. His poverty was for a purpose. His neediness opened the way for Him to meet our needs. His weariness is so that we might have His strength. Hebrews 4:15-16 tells us, "*For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.*" NKJV.
