## REVIVAL PREPARATION PLANS

***“If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.” (II Chronicles 7:14).***

Our season of revival is fast approaching here at Calvary. If you have not already completely cleared your calendar for November 1-4, sweep it clean! You've got to be here to be blessed! Rhyme and Reason will be here singing with Wayne Chasteen preaching each service. They will sing at our Harvest Fest event on October 31, and then revival services will begin during the morning service on November 1, and will continue at 7 P.M. Sunday evening through Wednesday evening.

November 1 has also been declared as ***NO ABSENTEE SUNDAY IN SUNDAY SCHOOL***. Our goal for that Sunday is for each class to have no less than the number of their total enrollment present for Sunday School as we kick off revival that Sunday morning. Each class needs to get busy contacting all active and inactive members and prospects and urging them to be here on that day. **DON'T FORGET** - the time change occurs that Saturday night, so fall back one hour!

In order to prepare our hearts for revival, the following will be happening in October:

### ***LAY HOSTED AND LAY-LED HOME PRAYER MEETINGS:***

Three successive Thursday nights - October 15, 22, and 29. The first of these prayer meetings will be held on October 15 and hosted by Rick and Becky Hill at their home. Locations and hosts of the other two meetings will be announced soon.

***7:14 PRAYER EMPHASIS:*** For the two Saturdays prior to the revival (October 24 and 31), we want people praying in the sanctuary every half-hour from the 7<sup>th</sup> hour (7 A.M.) until the 14<sup>th</sup> hour (2 P.M). A sign-up sheet for this prayer event is in the vestibule. When you come into the sanctuary on that day, please enter through the front door, and you will find instructions there.

***7:14 DAILY PRAYER:*** Set your watch chime for 7:14 A.M. or P.M., or both, and pause at that time to spend a few minutes in prayer for revival.

***YOUTH & CHILDREN'S EMPHASIS:*** On the Sunday Evening of the revival, we will have a Youth Pizza Blast at 5:30 P.M. at the Clubhouse, and a Children's Department Pizza Blast at 5:30 in the Fellowship Hall. This will give Bro. Wayne an opportunity to speak specifically to both groups. NOTE: We had thought about having a church-wide covered-dish supper that night, but those plans have been changed because this will be the best chance for Wayne to speak to our young people. Afterward, the youth and children will join us for the Sunday evening service of revival. NOTE ALSO: The normal Wednesday activities for youth and children will be suspended on the last night of the revival. We are urging our youth to “each one bring one” to revival.

***SUNDAY SCHOOL PRAYER EMPHASES:*** We're calling on every Sunday School class to spend a few minutes each Sunday in focused prayer for the revival, and for every adult class to plan some type of prayer emphasis or prayer event in the month of October. IDEAS: meet at the church at a certain time to pray, put together a prayer calendar for revival, put together a class-specific “hit list” of prayer requests for revival. Let your “sanctified imagination” run wild.

**VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED!!!!!!** In addition to the volunteers needed for the 7:14 Prayer Emphasis, volunteers are needed to take Rhyme and Reason (Wayne Chasteen, Mary McKinley and Casey McKinley) to dinner on Tuesday and Wednesday (November 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>) of revival. Please call the church office if you are willing to take on this responsibility.

Please be in prayer for me and for Sand Hill Baptist Church of Guyton, Georgia this week as I will be preaching their 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary Homecoming service on Sunday and then preaching revival services Monday through Wednesday. On Sunday, Bro. Lamar Herndon will be preaching the morning service, and then Bro. Beau James will share his testimony and his vision for Ministry 29 in the evening service. The Wednesday service will be our regular monthly business meeting. When I return, I'm planning to preach on November 18 and 25 two sermons on “Pictures of Revival” from II Kings 4-6 as we continue to move toward revival.

Also, if you have not already done so, let me urge you to obtain a copy of the little book called *The Calvary Road* by Roy Hession and read it prayerfully. As we said last week, you can order it in paperback form from christianbook.com or you can download it

The most important thing we can do to prepare for revival is to PRAY! I can't wait to see you all on the 18<sup>th</sup>. It is my prayer that our church will already be in the full flame of revival long before November 1 arrives. Join me in that prayer.
