The National Kidney Foundation's *Kidney Early Evaluation Program* (KEEP) is a free health screening program designed to help identify and educate individuals at increased risk - those who either have diabetes and/or hypertension or have first-degree relatives (parents, grandparents or siblings) with hypertension, diabetes or chronic kidney failure - with the purpose of delaying or preventing the development of chronic kidney disease. Diabetes and hypertension are the two leading causes of kidney failure.
