## KINGDOM KIDS CORNER

“Miss Elizabeth, LOOK!”

I had to have heard that statement 4,000 times this summer. Look at what I made. Look at what I did. Did you see that monkey? Look at that GIANT shark... YIKES!

As I think about returning back to school where no one fully appreciates the complexities of silly Vacation Bible School songs or screaming scripture because it is fun, I can't help but reflect on all God has done over the past several weeks. There have been moments when I had doubts. Moments I wondered if I could stand, teach, and stay coherent because I was so tired. There were several moments when I questioned my call into the ministry all together. Then, in the midst of my fleshly doubt, a child would come running up to me about how excited they were about the summer! All doubt and exhaustion vanishes when you see children praising God! This is what God has called me to do! This is what God has called Calvary to do!

Countless workers, volunteers, parents, grandparents, and great grandparents poured into the summer children's events this year. The summer was a success because of everyone who took the time to volunteer! We have been to the outskirts of the Outback on the Boomerang Express, the farm to see *Charlotte's Web*, the jungles of the Knoxville Zoo, on an adventure with Minnesota Cuke, climbed the Rock Raider's Mountain, and under the sea at the Ripley's Aquarium. For weeks, children have been running through the halls of the church singing, jumping, and playing. It may have all seemed like rowdy chaos, but in the midst of what appeared to be madness, God was moving in the lives of the children and adults who participated this summer.

I have been blessed to be apart of this ministry for the past three months, and I look forward to seeing all that God does through Calvary to reach the children and families of this neighborhood for Christ!
