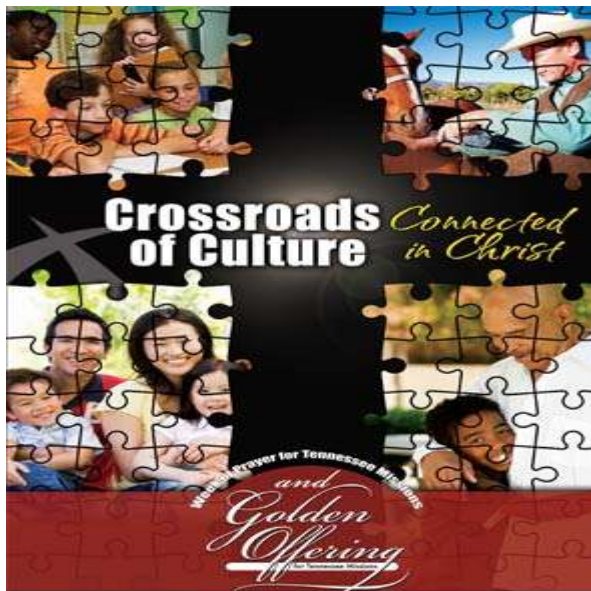

On Wednesday nights, we are continuing our series on "Hidden Hindering Spirits" with Dr. Ron Phillips.
