## Are you feeling red, pink, or yellow today?

You may not realize it, but colors affect the way you feel. Scientists have tested people's reaction to colors, and they found some interesting results. Yellows and oranges make people feel happier, warmer, and more active. Red is an even stronger color in this group in fact, red is such a strong color that it can make some people feel nervous. Blues and greens are calming colors. They make your blood pressure, heart rate, and breathing go slower. Another color that can help you feel peaceful and quiet is pink.

If you were decorating a fast-food restaurant, which colors would you choose to use? The next time you go for a hamburger or a pizza, notice the walls and decorations – even the signs out in front of the restaurant. Most fast-food places stay away from greens, pinks, and blues, because these colors make people, as well as their appetites, slow down. Oranges and yellows are the best colors to inspire people to eat a lot, eat faster, and leave sooner; that way, there is room for even more customers to come in and do the same thing.

### So what?

Colors may temporarily change our moods, but there is something much more lasting than fabrics or paints to change our personalities. God wants to help you change in ways that are positive and permanent. *The Bible lets us know that God can do this:*

If something is bothering you, don't just look for a cheerful room to make you feel better. That won't work for very long. Instead, take your problem to God. When He helps you, it won't be just temporary!
