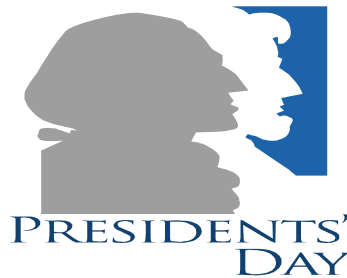

## Kingsport Area Food Ministry

*Belvue Christian Church – Calvary Baptist Church – Kingsport Community Church – Temple Baptist Church*

*“Churches Working Together for Grocery Relief”*

*Who qualifies?*

Everyone, there are no applications or qualifications to order Angel Food.

*Where does the food come from?*

Our food is “restaurant grade” meats, frozen vegetables, fruits, dairy products, etc. which we acquire through our involvement with only the best producers/vendors of high quality, “name brand” foods. Never “seconds” or “day old” type products are involved.

*Can we purchase more than one unit or special?*

Yes, you can purchase as many regular units as you would like. To purchase a special box you must first order a regular unit.

*Where do I pay and pick up my food?*

Contact the church office or Tony Queen for details. Angel Food Ministries is a non-profit, non-denominational organization dedicated to providing grocery relief and financial support to communities throughout the United States.

*Blessings by the box*

Angel Food is available in a quantity that can fit into a medium sized box at \$30 per unit. Each month's menu is different from the previous month and consists of both fresh and frozen items with an average retail value of approximately \$60.

### **How the Program works**

Food sales and distribution are handled by **Kingsport Area Food Ministry**. Kingsport Area Food Ministry collects orders and payments during the first part of each month. These orders are then turned in to the Angel Food main office in Georgia. Several days later, in the same month, food is delivered to **Kingsport Area Food Ministry**.
